

# Spit East Upgrade



## STAGES



New laneway, bus bay and bus shelter and traffic calming along the foreshore  
**November 2018**



New seats, bike hoops and landscaping of garden beds and trees along the foreshore  
**January 2019**



New parking area, upgrading of the laneway and footpaths adjacent to the commercial district  
**March/April 2019**  
*Laneway closure*



New paving and landscaping with trees and garden beds adjacent the commercial district  
**May 2019**



The **first stage** commenced in October 2018 and includes a new bus bay, bus shelter and levelling the road to allow for a new paved laneway. This will also enable traffic calming in the area. There will be no disturbances to the bus or its timetable during these works. Thirteen car spaces currently situated adjacent to the foreshore will be removed and replaced in the second stage, there will be no net loss of car parking.

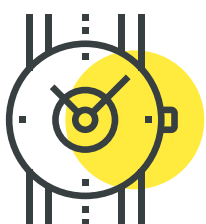
The **end of stage one** will see new bike hoops and seats erected along the foreshore as well as the landscaping of new garden beds and trees.

The **second stage** begins in early March 2019 and will see upgrades to the existing laneway and footpaths as well as including a new parking area and new loading zones. There will be limited access through the existing laneway from March until May.

The **end of stage two** will see new paving adjacent to the Spit East commercial district as well as landscaping of new garden beds.

Overall there will be seven trees removed during these works and eighteen new trees planted.

There will be pedestrian access to all businesses and the foreshore during the works and the Spit East Car Park will operate as normal.
